

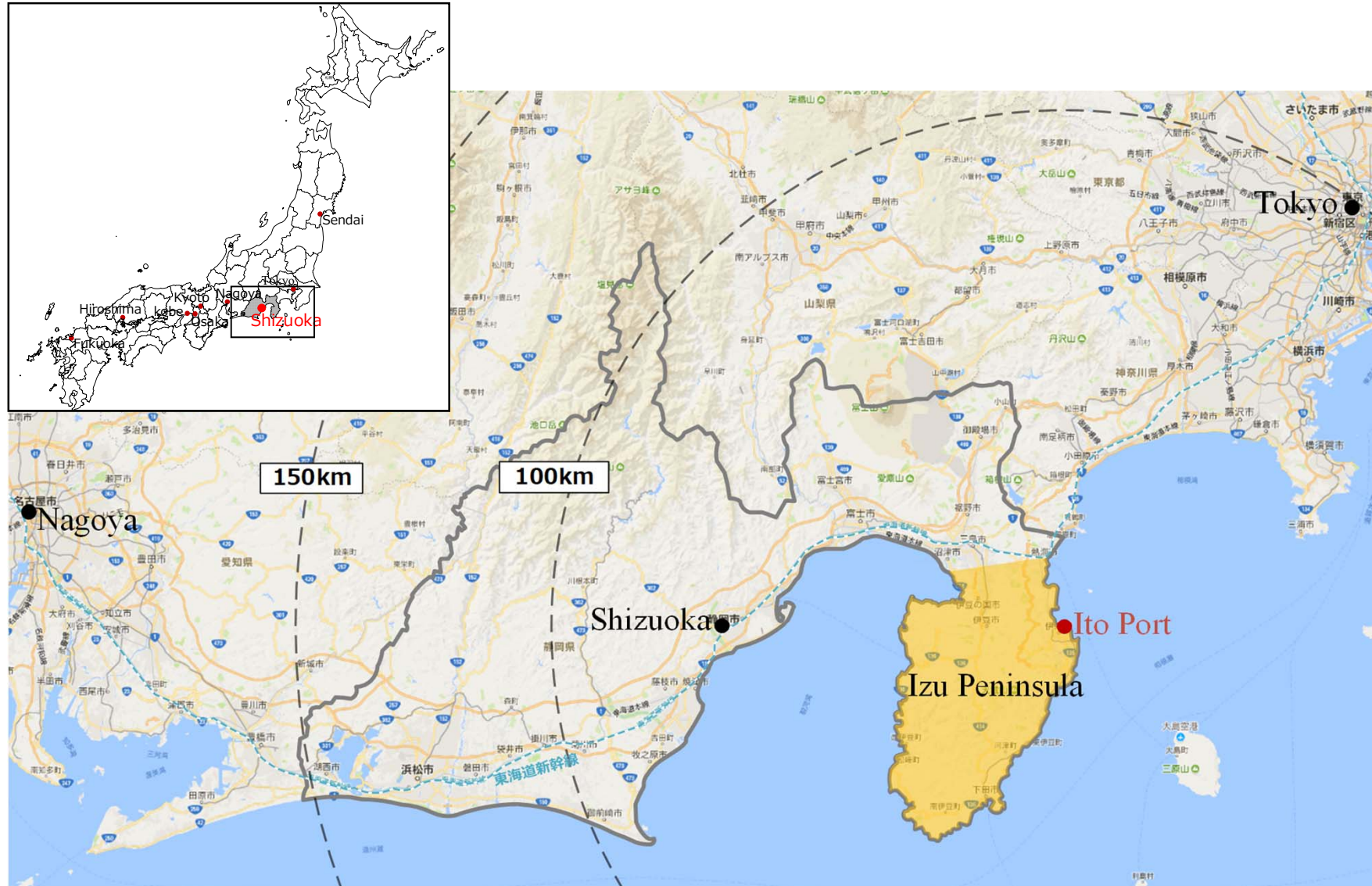

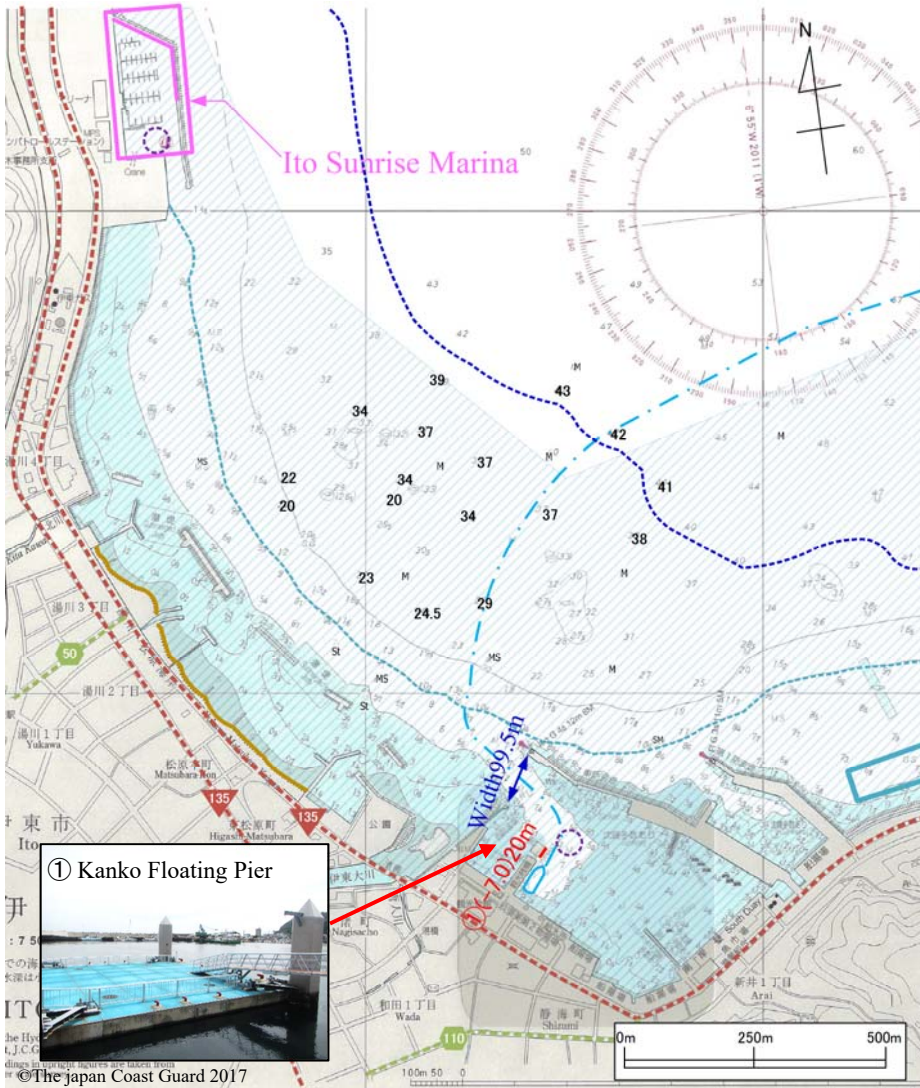
# 1. Location of Ito Port

※ May not be available if the schedule overlaps with cargo handling and other operations of Tokai Kisen

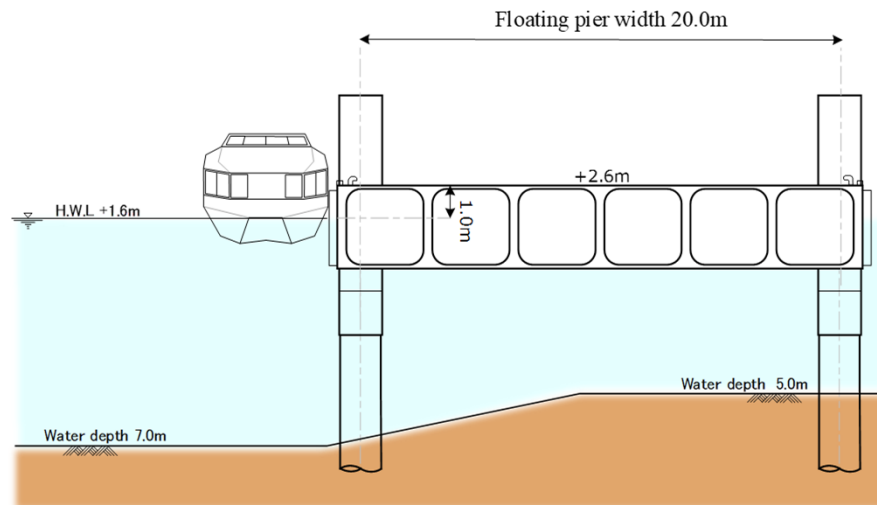

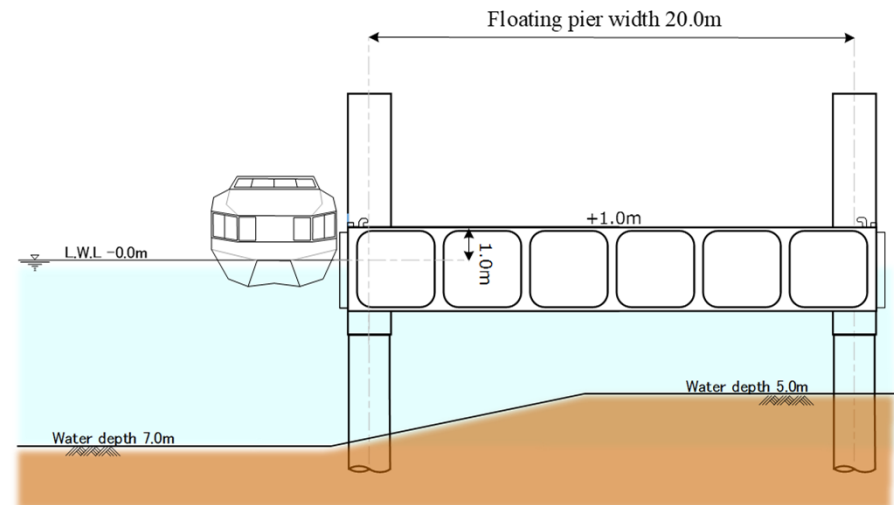

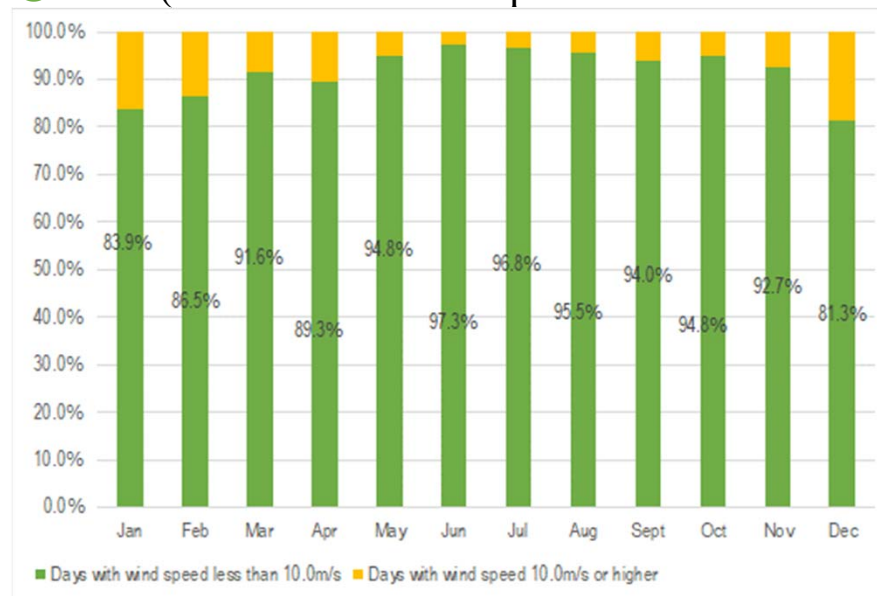
Suitable Port Call Timing (Weather Condition)	<b>March - November</b>

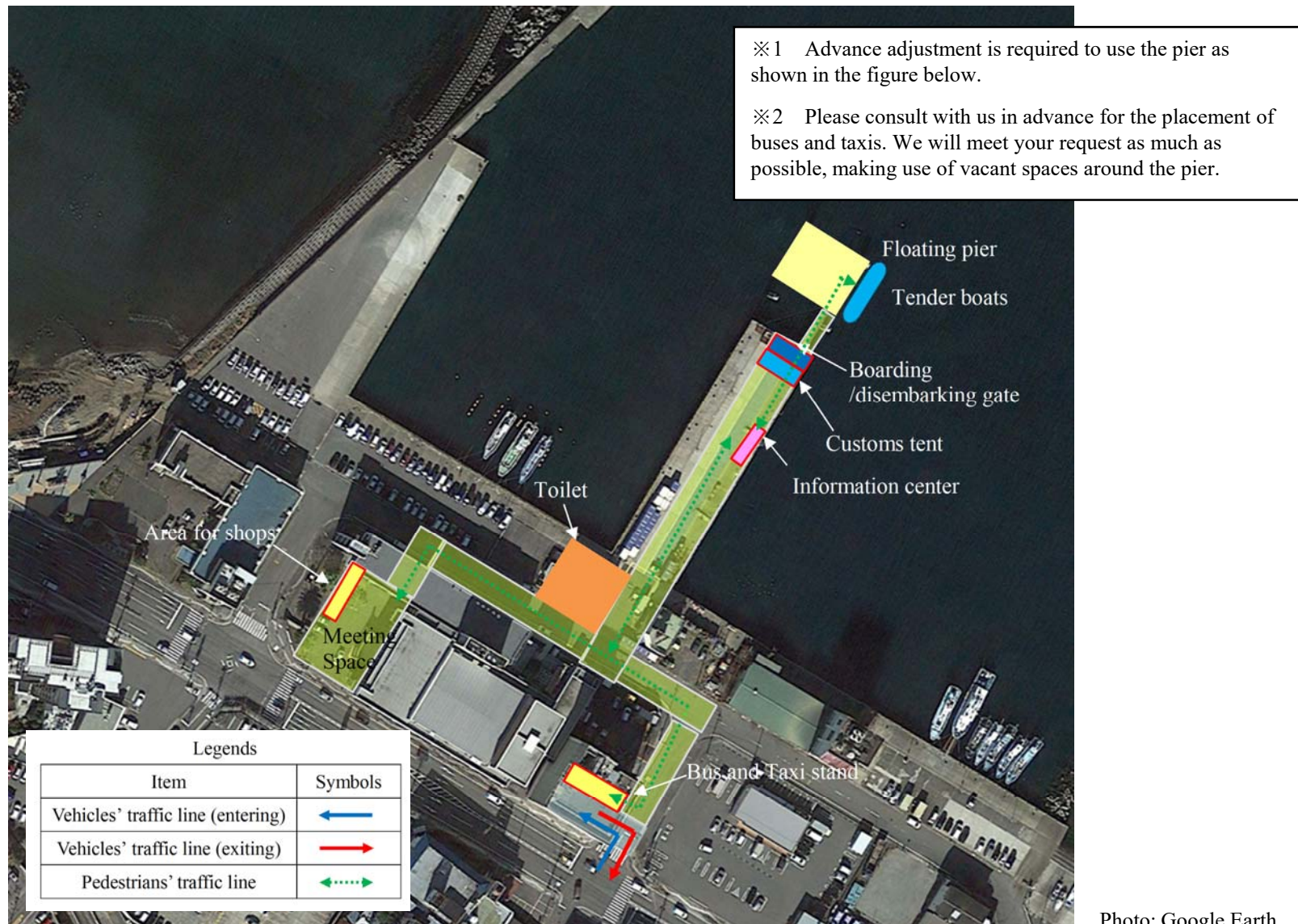

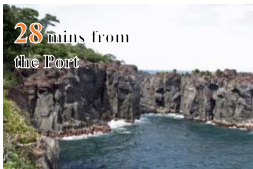
## 5. Flow Planning (2) (Planned use of Sunrise Marina)

**15 Akazawa One-day Visit Onsen Kan**  
**Parking: 160 cars**  
 Onsen facilities with an outstanding panoramic view of the Pacific.



**1 Michi-no-eki Ito Marine Town**  
**Parking: 293 cars and 14 large vehicles**  
 Complex facilities located at the gateway to Ito.



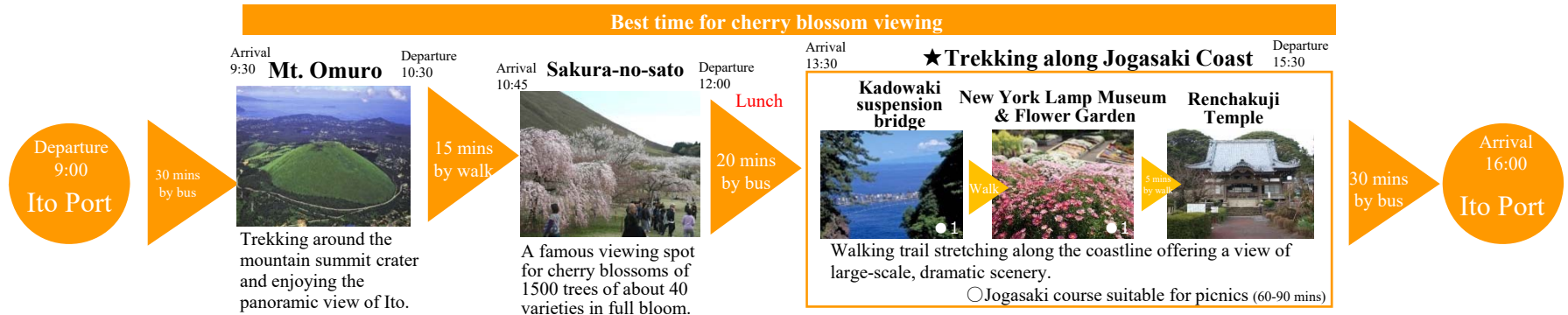
**6 Izukogen Tabi-no-eki Granpal Port**

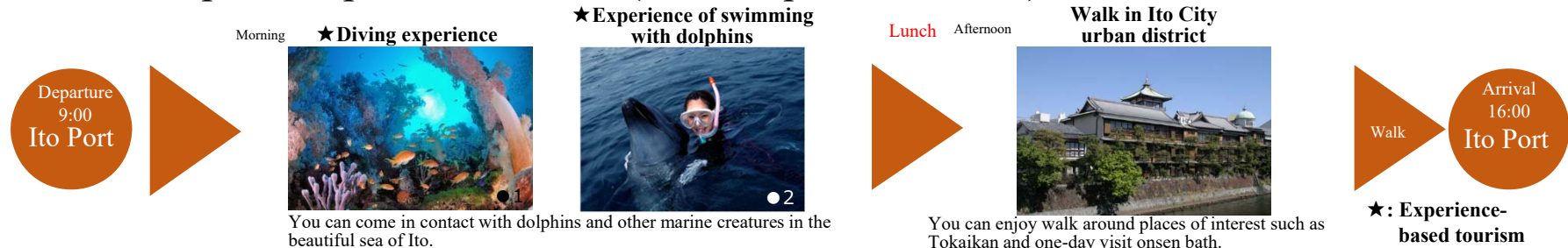

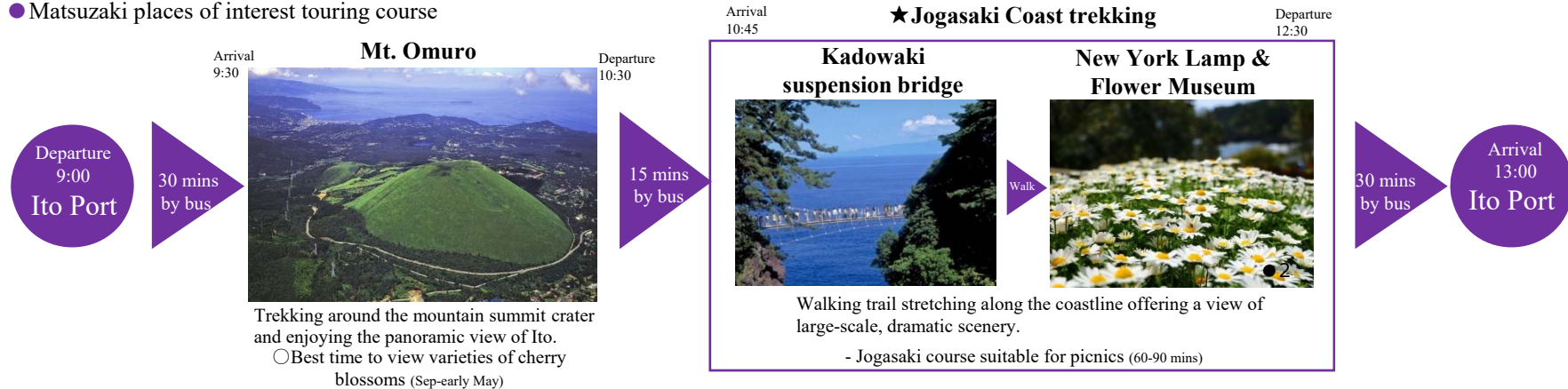

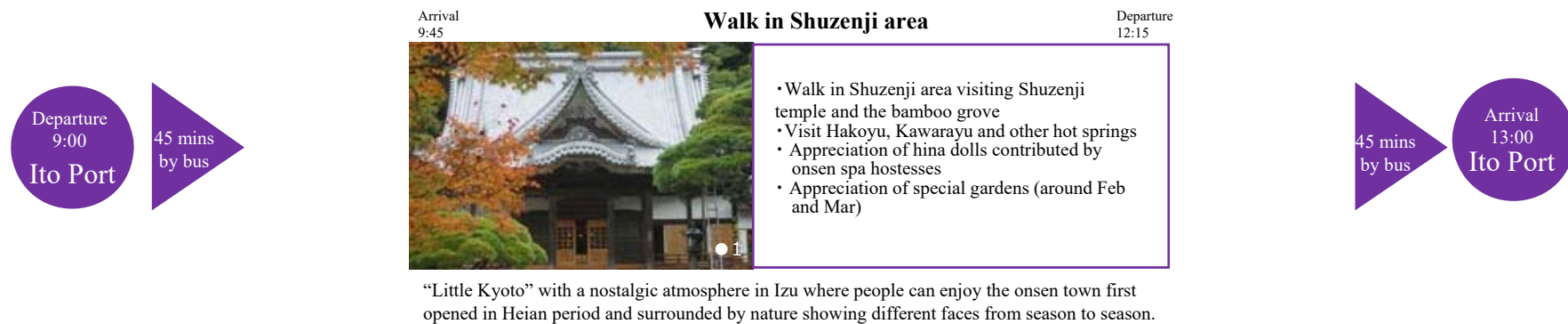

⑦ **Mokutaro Kinoshita Memorial Museum**
